Methodology

Each year, Students Run LA (SRLA) collects graduation information on its senior class.

SRLA collected this data by first asking SRLA seniors to fill out an online graduation survey. A unique link was e-mailed to each senior that included a personalized survey that asked questions about plans after high school. SRLA followed up several times with additional outreach for students who did not initially respond.


For seniors who failed to respond to the survey after multiple attempts, SRLA followed up with their SRLA Marathon Leaders. Having teachers who could follow up with their students directly significantly increased the response rate from prior years.

The SRLA Class of 2023 is made up of 521 seniors who completed the full season with SRLA, making it all the way to Marathon Day. Although four seniors were not able to complete the full marathon, their data is included in this report. Only 3 seniors, just 0.57%, did not report any information on high school graduation or plans after college. With teachers back in the classroom with their students, SRLA's data collection rates have increased dramatically as the following response rates reflect: 76.5% in 2020, 87.3% in 2021, and 98.7% in 2022.


Overall Statistics SRLA Class of 2023

Historically, SRLA has reported a 99% graduation rate with 95% of those graduates having plans to attend college in the fall. The SRLA Class of 2023 reported similar results.



Only 7 students reported that they were not graduating this June. Two of these students, who have learning disabilities, earned certificates of completion (not a high school diploma) and will be attending a special education magnet school in the fall. Another student is planning to attend a trade school while the plans of the other students are unknown.


SRLA Class of 2023 - Higher Education Plans



For the 28 students who reported not having plans to attend college:

- 11 are joining the military;
- 3 are working;
- 3 are attending trade schools;
- 2 are attending a special education magnet school; and
- 9 have other plans.

SRLA Class of 2023 - First-Generation College Students



Of the 480+ SRLA students who have plans to attend college this fall, 377 are among the first generation of their families to go to college.

Statistics by Gender SRLA Class of 2023

Historically, female SRLA seniors report plans to attend college at higher rates than their male peers. In 2023, 99% of responding SRLA female graduates reported having plans to attend college as compared to 98% of male graduates. Once again, a larger percentage of SRLA women than men report plans to attend college. Similarly, a larger percentage of women than men report being among the first-generation of their families to attend college.
